ECWS structure, activities and roles

1st PHASE: START UP

Kick-off meeting. During the start up meeting the Steering Committee will discuss and approve all the project's structure, the activities, the roles and the financial issues.



ECWS structure, activities and roles

2nd PHASE: SENSIBILISATION AND SELECTION

This step has the target to inform the young people in order to involve them in to the project.

The sensibilisation activity will be made using mainly the Municipalities channel and using the Networks of the private organizations.

Selection criteria: 4 young people for each partner (2 males, 2 females. 3 aged between 18-25 years, 1 aged between 26-30 years)



ECWS structure, activities and roles

3rd PHASE: EMPOWERMENT

This step has the objective to assure a basic preparation about the themes of the project.

The activity foresees the realization of 2 workshops in each country



ECWS structure, activities and roles

1. Workshop “European Commission”. This workshop will be centred in order to give information to the young people about the European Union, how the main institution works, with particular regard to the European Commission.
2. Workshop “Main challenges of XXI century, social inclusion and youth unemployment”. The young people will be updated about the european policies about social inclusion and youth unemployment.



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4th PHASE: PARTECIPATED PREPARATION

This activity has the objective to train the young people in order to manage the transnational meeting.

The young beneficiaries, with the help of the experts, will prepare the tools and documents to be used during the transnational meetings. Particularly they will prepare a presentation concerning their national policy about the 2 main topics.



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5th PHASE: TRANSNATIONAL MEETING

The youth people from different countries will meet in Reggio Calabria in December 2013 for 4 working days to simulate the work and decision-making procedures of the Europe Commission and to share their opinion and ideas about the two main topics.



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6th PHASE: MONITORING, EVALUATION AND FOLLOW UP

This activity is crucial in order to fully understand the expected impact of the project.

The overall objective of the monitoring and evaluation system is to evaluate the efficacy and efficiency of the activities.
